## Missionary Breakout Sessions

Chai, Chilis, and Gospel Conversations, *led by Michelle & Jonathon Swafford*. Drinking tea and eating meals (Caution: spicy!) brings opportunities to share the Gospel and start Chronological Bible-Storying groups. South Asia has the greatest concentration of lostness in the world. But God is opening doors and doing great things! Come and hear what God is doing and how you can be involved!

# **Leading Well Breakout Sessions**
