

## It's Bible Drill Time in Tennessee!! Tips for Starting Bible Drill, Jr.

Bible Drill Jr. is a fun, hands-on discipleship program for 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> graders. Bible Drill, Jr. is designed to help Jr. drillers develop Bible skills. Drillers participating in Bible Drill, Jr. will primarily focus on learning the books of the Bible, where they are located, and how to find them. Jr. drillers will memorize 8 Bible verses and the location of 3 key passages from the current Bible Drill cycle.

As you begin this season of Bible Drill here are a few tips to keep in mind.

Tip 1: Enlist at least two (2) leaders over the age of 18 to serve each week in Bible Drill, Jr.

Tip 2: Set date, time, and location for weekly Bible Drill, Jr. meetings. Be sure to check your church calendar for any conflict.

Tip 3: Plan a kickoff event. Invite 1st – 3rd graders, along with their parents, to a fun event that introduces them to Bible Drill, Jr. During this event include Bible Skill games and activities that encourages children and their parents to participate. This event can be part of your Children's Bible Drill kickoff event. If you currently have Children's Bible Drill, you may consider inviting current drillers to present a demonstration drill.

Tip 4: Download a copy of the Bible Drill, Jr. – Blue Cycle materials from the TBMB website. <a href="www.tnbaptist.org/childrens-bible-drill">www.tnbaptist.org/childrens-bible-drill</a> and become familiar with its content. Bible Drill, Jr. materials will be available on July 15<sup>th</sup>.

Tip 5: Secure an approved Bible Drill Bible for each driller: Bibles are available at <u>lifeway.com</u>.
