

Children's Bible Drill 2026

Practice Drill A

Green Cycle

I. Our first section will be the “Book Call”. I will give the name of a book in the Bible and you will find the book. Place a finger on any verse in the book named and step forward. If I call your number, you will say the book before the one named, the book named and the book that follows.

1. Attention.

Present Bibles.

Exodus. (pause)

Start. (*Call on a child after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER: Genesis, EXODUS, Leviticus

2. Attention.

Present Bibles.

Isaiah. (pause)

Start. (*Call on a child after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER: Song of Solomon, ISAIAH, Jeremiah

3. Attention.

Present Bibles.

II Kings (pause)

Start. (*Call on a child after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER: I Kings, II KINGS, 1 Chronicles

4. Attention.

Present Bibles.

Luke. (pause)

Start. (*Call on a child after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER: Mark, LUKE, John

5. Attention.

Present Bibles.

Romans. (pause)

Start. (*Call on a child after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER: Acts, ROMANS, I Corinthians

6. Attention.

Present Bibles.

Hebrews. (pause)

Start. (Call on a child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER: Philemon, HEBREWS, James

This ends the Book Drill.

II. We will now have the “Key Passage Drill”. I will give the title of a key passage. You will find the passage, place a finger on any verse in the passage, and step forward. If called upon, I will ask you to state the key passage title, the reference, and will ask you to read a verse within that passage.

Judges and children, we now begin the Key Passage Drill.

1. Attention.

Present Bibles.

The Greatness of God (pause)

Start. (Call on a child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER: The Greatness of God/Isaiah 40

Please read verse 31. (PAGE TURN IS ACCEPTABLE IN CSB)

KJV – Isaiah 40:31 “But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.”

CSB – Isaiah 40:31 “but those who trust in the LORD will renew their strength; they will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not become weary, they will walk and not faint.”

2. Attention.

Present Bibles.

The First Lord’s Supper (pause)

Start. (Call on a child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER: The First Lord’s Supper / Luke 22:15-20

Please read verse 17. (PAGE TURN IS ACCEPTABLE IN CSB)

KJV – Luke 22:17 - And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, Take this, and divide it among yourselves:

CSB – Luke 22:17 – Then he took a cup, and after giving thanks, he said, “Take this and share it among yourselves.

3. Attention.
Present Bibles.

The Crucifixion (pause)

Start. (Call on a child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER: The Crucifixion / John 19

Please read verse 30. (PAGE TURN IS ACCEPTABLE IN KJV/CSB)

KJV – John 19:30 – When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, It is finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.

CSB – John 19:30 – When Jesus had received the sour wine, he said, “It is finished.” Then bowing his head, he gave up his spirit.

4. Attention.
Present Bibles.

A Psalm of Praise (pause)

Start. (Call on a child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER: A Psalm of Praise / Psalm 100

Please read verse 2. (PAGE TURN IS ACCEPTABLE IN CSB)

KJV – Psalm 100:2 – Serve the Lord with gladness: come before his presence with singing.

CSB – Psalm 100:2 – Serve the Lord with gladness; come before him with joyful songs.

5. Attention.
Present Bibles.

The Faith Chapter (pause)

Start. (Call on a child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER: The Faith Chapter / Hebrews 11

Please read verse 3. (PAGE TURN IS ACCEPTABLE IN KJV/CSB)

KJV – Hebrews 11:3 Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

CSB – Hebrews 11:3 By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God, so that what is seen was made from things that are not visible.

6. Attention.
Present Bibles.

Jesus and Nicodemus (pause)

Start. (Call on a child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER: The Ten Commandments / Exodus 20:3-17

Please read verse 11. (PAGE TURN IS ACCEPTABLE IN KJV)

KJV – Exodus 20:12 – Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.

CSB – Exodus 20:12 – Honor your father and your mother so that you may have a long life in the land that the Lord your God is giving you.

This ends the Key Passage Drill.

III. We will now have the Quotation Drill. You may place your Bibles on the floor behind you OR continue to hold your Bibles. I will give the reference of a verse. If you know the verse, step forward and when called upon quote the verse and reference. Please speak slowly and clearly, so that the Judges and I can hear you correctly.

Judges and children, we now begin the Quotation Drill.

1. Attention.

II Timothy 1:7 (pause)

Start. (Call on child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV – “For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.” II Timothy 1:7

CSB - “For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but one of power, love, and sound judgment.” II Timothy 1:7

2. Attention.

Genesis 1:1 (pause)

Start. (Call on child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV - In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. Genesis 1:1

CSB - In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Genesis 1:1

3. Attention.

Proverbs 15:1 (pause)

Start. (Call on child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV – A soft answer turneth away wrath: but grievous words stir up anger Proverbs 15:1

CSB – A gentle answer turns away anger; but a harsh word stirs up wrath. Proverbs 15:1

4. Attention.

Psalm 119:105 (pause)

Start. (Call on child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV - “Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.” Psalm 119:105

CSB - “Your word is a lamp for my feet and a light on my path.” Psalm 119:105

5. Attention.

John 3:16 (pause)

Start. (Call on child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV – For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. John 3:16

CSB - For God loved the world in this way: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16

6. Attention.

Romans 12:1 (pause)

Start. (Call on child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV – I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. Romans 12:1

CSB - Therefore, brothers and sisters, in view of the mercies of God, I urge you to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God; this is your true worship. Romans 12:1

This ends the Quotation Drill.

IV. We will now have the Completion Drill. I will give you a portion of a verse of Scripture. If you know the entire verse and where it is found, step forward. When called upon, recite the entire verse and the reference.

(Note to Caller: When using more than one version, say: "Some of you are using different versions of the Bible. I will name the version and the portion of the verse for each version represented. If I call on you during the drill for the correct response, you may ask me to repeat the verse again.")

Judges and Children, we now begin the Completion Drill.

1. Attention.

KJV - "This is the day which the Lord hath made..." (pause)

CSB - "This is the day the Lord has made..." (pause)

Start. (Call on a child after "time" has been called.)

ANSWER:

**KJV - "This is the day which the LORD hath made; we will rejoice and be glad in it."
Psalm 118:24**

**CSB - "This is the day the LORD has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it."
Psalm 118:24**

2. Attention

KJV - "And we know that all things work together for good..." (pause)

CSB - "We know that all things work together for the good..." (pause)

Start. (Call on a child after "time" has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV - "And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose." Romans 8:28

CSB - "We know that all things work together for the good of those who love God, who are called according to his purpose." Romans 8:28

3. Attention.

KJV - “The Lord is good...” (pause)

CSB - “The Lord is good...” (pause)

Start.

(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV - “The Lord is good, a strong hold in the day of trouble; and he knoweth them that trust in him.” Nahum 1:7

CSB - “The Lord is good, a stronghold in a day of distress; he cares for those who take refuge in him.” Nahum 1:7

4. Attention.

KJV - “And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted...” (pause)

CSB - “And be kind and compassionate to one another...” (pause)

Start.

(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV - “And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.” Ephesians 4:32

CSB - “And be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving one another, just as God also forgave you in Christ.” Ephesians 4:32

5. Attention.

KJV - “The grass withereth,...” (pause)

CSB - “The grass withers,...” (pause)

Start.

(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV - “The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: but the word of our God shall stand for ever.” Isaiah 40:8

CSB - “The grass withers, the flowers fade, but the word of our God remains forever.” Isaiah 40:8

6. Attention.

KJV - “Moreover it is required...” (pause)

CSB - “In this regard, it is required...” (pause)

Start.

(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV - “Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful.”

I Corinthians 4:2

CSB - “In this regard, it is required that managers be found faithful.” I Corinthians 4:2

We have now completed the Completion Drill.

We are finished! Thank you boys and girls for doing such a wonderful job. Our judges will now leave to tally the results of our Drill. Parents, at this time it will be fine to take pictures. While our Judges are getting the results together, we will say the Books of the Bible. Number one, will you begin please?

(You may use this time in several ways. Testimonies by drillers of what Bible Drill means to them or sharing a fun time their Bible Drill has shared together are some possibilities as you wait for the Judges to return.)

After the return of the judges, pass out the Children’s Bible Drill certificates. Then dismiss the drillers and prepare for the next drill.
