
Annual Church Profile

2025 Statistical Profile Instructions

Step ONE: Update Your Organization Home Page

Type in your church's ACP UserName and Password in **TeD** at TN.SBCWorskSpace.com. You should see your Home Page as follows. Click on your church name in the **Organization Box**.





Check the contact information on the Organization Page for accuracy. This includes:

- primary **PHONE** number for reaching the church
- church WEBSITE address if applicable
- primary EMAIL address for contacting the church
- usernames for **FACEBOOK**, **INSTAGRAM**, and **X** if applicable
- church MAILING ADDRESS and PHYSICAL ADRESS, indicating which is Preferred


Make changes as needed, then click on the blue **SAVE ORGANIZATION** box on the top right of the page. Click **HOME** to return to the Home Page.






Step TWO: Open Your 2025 ACP Statistical Profile

Return to the Home Page as shown above and click on **2025 ACP Statistical Profile**.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Use this worksheet as a tool for gathering your church's information. Mark on this form as you wish. Once information is gathered, log on to ted.tnbaptist.org and enter this data.
- Your username and password are at the top of your statistical profile form provided by your association. If you do not have internet access, transfer the data to the statistical profile form and submit to your association.
- Your Due Date is set by your association. For your church to be reflected in the annual SBC and TBC ACP Totals, data must be entered into the system prior to February 15, 2026.
- Church-type missions should complete their own ACP Worksheet. Please contact your associational office staff or TBMB staff if you need more information.

6	AVERAGE ATTENDANCE Sunday School/Rible Study/Small Group — Average number

attending weekly, in-person Bible Study during this reporting year. This includes all days of the



week and all ages.

7	TOTAL ENROLLMENT Sunday School/Small Group/Life Group Participation — Number of individual persons enrolled or who regularly participate in Sunday school or similar small groups ministry. Base enrollment or participation as of the last regular meeting of this reporting year. Count persons only one time in total enrollment. Include leaders.

If records are not kept, give a good-faith estimate.
9	TOTAL ENROLLMENT Vacation Bible School (VBS) — Total enrolled in all Vacation Bible School (VBS) or Backyard Kids Club (BKC) held by your church this reporting year. Combine numbers if you had multiple events or locations.
10	TOTAL PARTICIPATION Mission Projects (all groups) — Total number of persons in your congregation who participated in international, domestic, state, and local mission projects. Individuals may be counted more than once. Include ministries such as church planting construction, evangelistic surveys, Disaster Relief, World Changers, Acteen Activators, etc.

11	TOTAL RECEIPTS — Total amount of all money received by the congregation. 12	UNDESIGNATED OFFERINGS/General Budget Gifts — Total amount of all undesignated gifts given by individuals. Undesignated receipts are gifts where the congregation decides how the money will be spent, whether by its budget or some other means. This includes regular budget offerings and loose money from the offering but does not include any special offerings or designated gifts.
