over my lips!"**

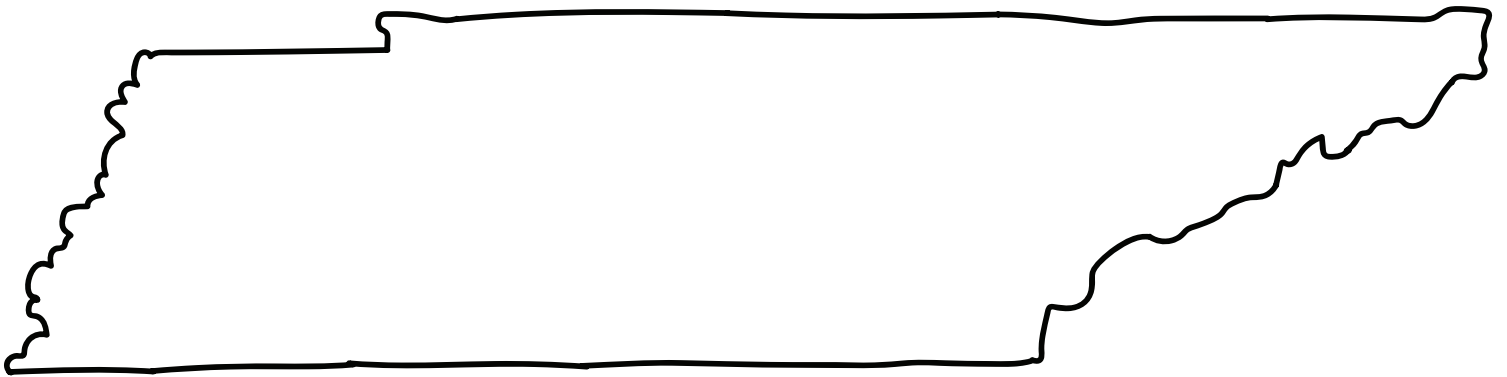


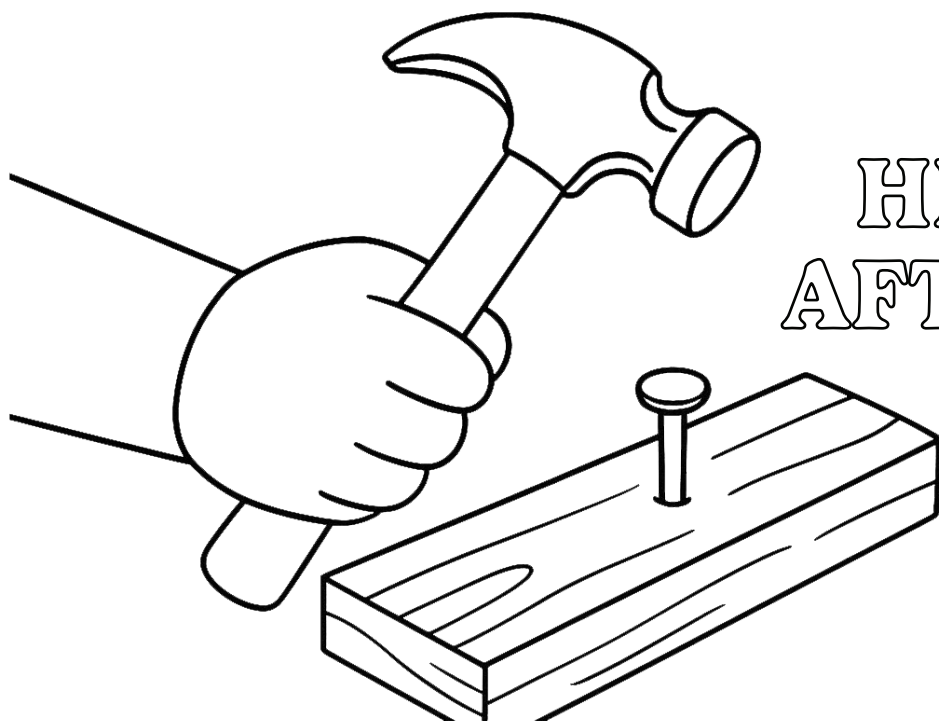
**They counted the money -

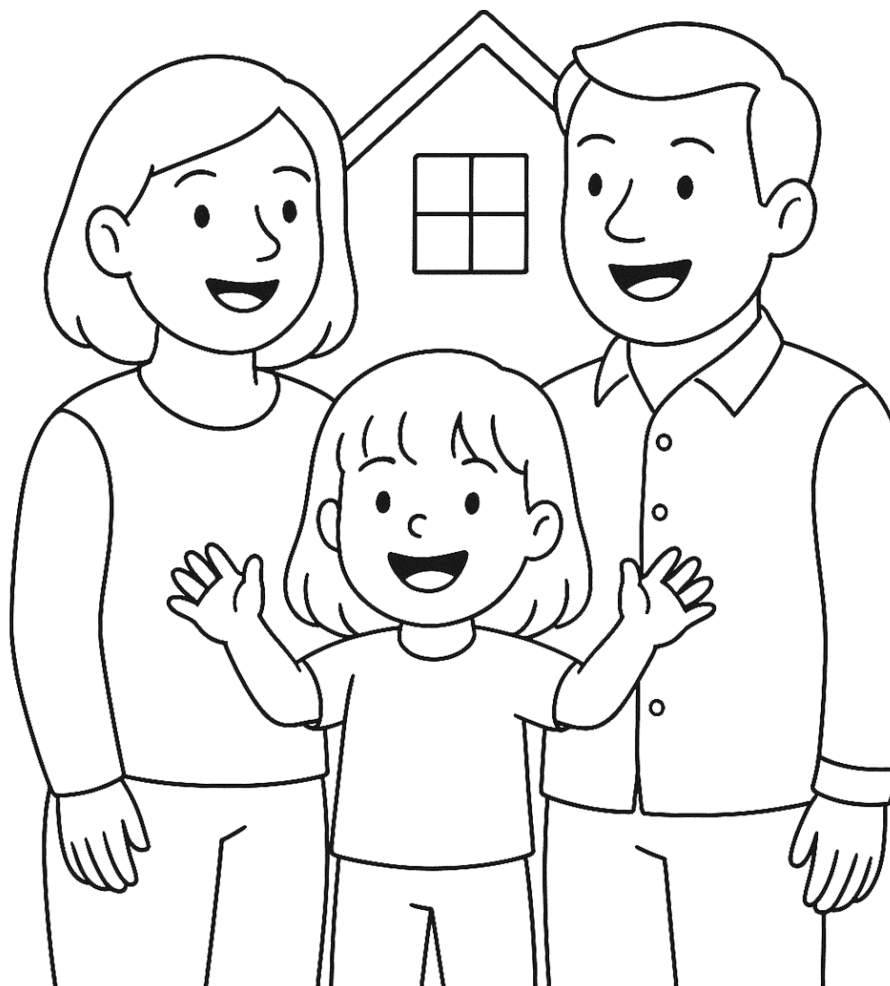

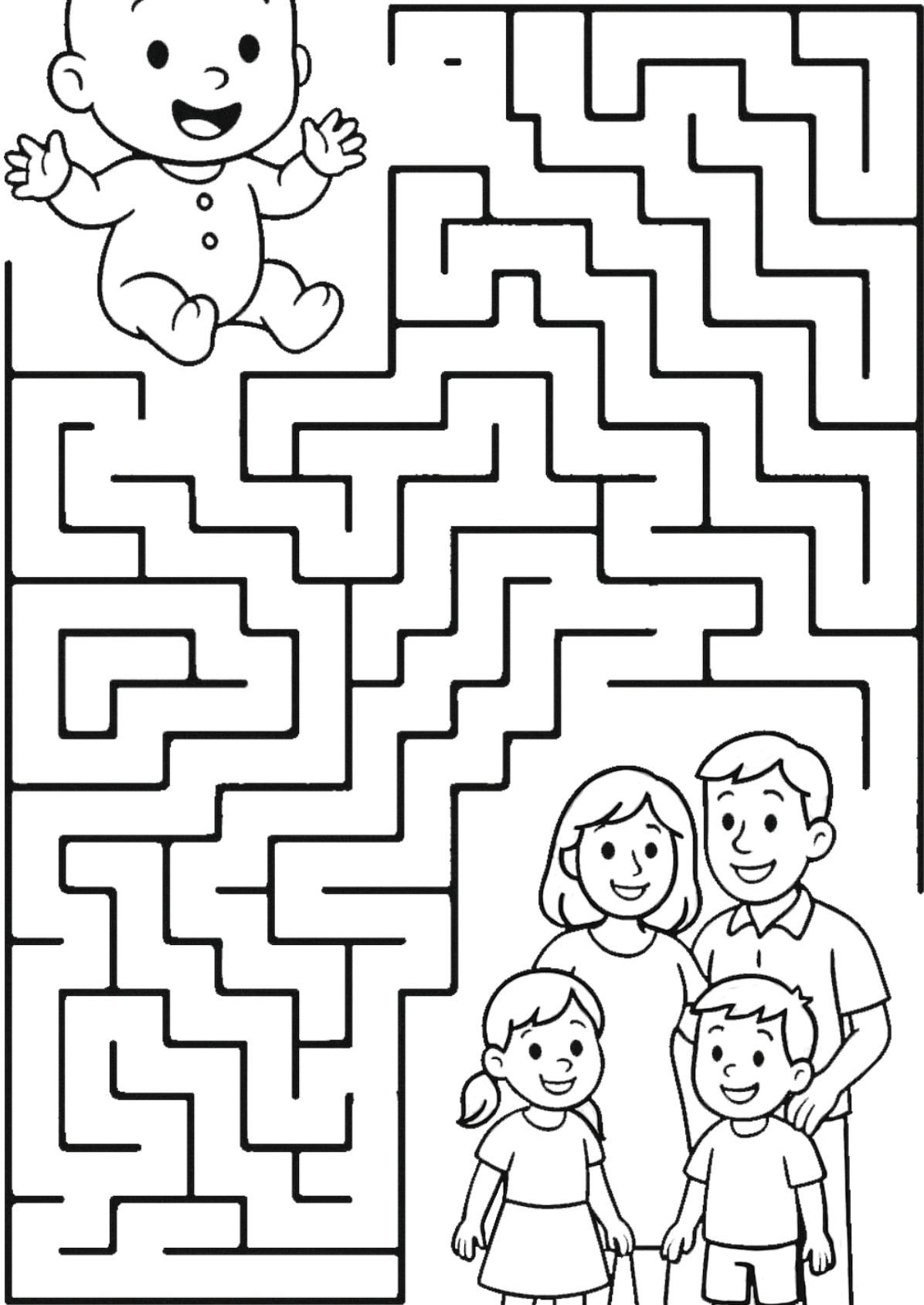
