

PRAYER WALKING at your CHURCH

Begin every time of prayer by asking the Holy Spirit to guide your prayers. What you read below are suggestions.

As you walk around the campus pray . . .

- for the Father to place a hedge of protection around your church, keeping the physical facility from harm and every adult and child safe
- for the safety team to be well-trained and alert at all times
- for playgrounds to be filled with the laughter of children
- for greeters working parking lots or entrances to be focused on greeting both members and visitors with enthusiasm and sincerity

As you walk inside your church pray . . .

- for the spiritual health of each pastor/minister (pray for them by name)
- for pastors/ministers to be encouraged by church members
- that the focus of each ministry would be to point individuals to Jesus
- for each person entering the building do so expecting to have an encounter with God
- for those without Christ to be captivated by the worship through music and the truth of God's Word that is preached, and come to know Christ as their Savior
- for visitors to be welcomed in a manner that will cause them to know they have been seen and will cause them to want to come back
- that the conversation around the coffee area would be pleasing to the Lord and for every person getting coffee to be acknowledged
- over every area of the worship center
- over every chair in every Life Group room
- over the preschool and children's areas—pray the children will learn that church is a safe place where they are loved and are of great worth and value
- for the worship to bring glory to the Father
- for every word spoken to be filled with God's Truth
- for those who care for your facility
- There are a host of other areas to be prayed over. Before you leave, be sure to thank the Father for your church family and His many blessings—grace, mercy, and salvation to name a few
