» THE MODEL

To **GROW** to be more like Jesus.




To **GO** and be the hands and feet of Jesus to the community.



What **BELIEFS** do we want kids and students to know?

GOD

PS: God is good and loves me.

KD: There is only one God, and He created all things.

PT: God is holy and deserves worship and obedience.

MS: God is eternal, all-powerful, all-knowing, and all-present.

HS: God is sovereign over all creation and reveals Himself to mankind through His Word.

JESUS

PS: Jesus loves me.

KD: Jesus is God's son and came to earth, died on the cross for my sins, and rose from the dead.

PT: Jesus is the only way to a relationship with God

MS: Jesus is fully God and fully man, and despite being tempted while on earth, remained sinless.

HS: Jesus, being fully God, demonstrated His power to forgive sin by performing miracles. He is now seated at the right hand of God and will one day return to reign over His creation and make all things new.

HOLY SPIRIT

PS: God helps me.

KD: The Holy Spirit convicts me of my sin.

PT: The Holy Spirit is given to a person when he trusts Jesus as Savior and Lord. He gives me power to live in obedience to God.

MS: The Holy Spirit comforts and strengthens a believer.

HS: The Holy Spirit endows me with spiritual gifts to use for serving the Church and produces the fruit of the spirit in my life.

What **BELIEFS** do we want kids and students to know?

BIBLE

BIBLE

PS: The Bible is a special book that tells about God.

KD: The Bible is completely true and has no errors.

PT: The Bible is the only inspired, written Word of God, and is God's message about Himself and His salvation plan through Jesus.

MS: Through the Bible, I can know God Himself and how He expects me to live.

HS: The Bible is internally consistent, true, without error, totally trustworthy, and will last forever.

SALVATION

SALVATION

PS: God sent Jesus because He loves me.

KD: I need salvation because my sin separates me from a relationship with God. Jesus died on the cross for my sins so that I can receive salvation.

PT: I can receive salvation by confessing my sin and believing in Jesus as the son of God, and that He died on the cross for my sin.

MS: Salvation is by grace alone in faith alone, in Jesus alone and cannot be lost once received.

HS: No amount of good works can save me—only Jesus paying the payment for my sin can reconcile me with God.

CREATION

CREATION

PS: God made all things—day, night, plants, sky, sun, moon, stars, animals, water, birds, fish, and me.

KD: God made all things from nothing.

PT: Creation can only be credited to God.

MS: Creation testifies to God's existence.

HS: Creation testifies to God's existence, and people are without excuse for their disbelief and disobedience.



CHURCH

PS: People at church love one another and help others.

KD: People gather at church to worship God and study the Bible.

PT: The church is a fellowship of baptized believers who are a part of the movement Jesus and His followers began.

MS: The church is not a place or building, but the people who belong to the family of God.

HS: The church is to gather regularly, participate in the ordinances of baptism, which represents my sharing in Jesus' burial and resurrection, and the Lord's Supper, which represents the body and blood of Jesus as the payment for my sin.

PEOPLE

PS: God made me so I am special.

KD: God created every person in His image, and they are unique and of value to God.

PT: God wants people to communicate with Him and study the Bible daily.

MS: God expects people to remain pure in all aspects of life because a person's body is the temple of God.

HS: People are created as moral beings and are responsible for their choices and the consequences of their choices, including the ways I treat others.

FAMILY

PS: God made families to help one another.

KD: God tells children to respect and obey their parents.

PT: Families are part of God's plan for providing for children's spiritual, physical, mental, social, and emotional needs.

MS: God's plan for the family involves one man and one woman committing to one another in a lifelong covenant relationship called marriage, reflecting God's love for His people.

HS: When families experience brokenness such as conflict, abuse, or divorce, God desires to bring healing and unity and to use the family of God to minister to hurting families during difficult times.

COMMUNITY/WORLD

PS: God cares about and loves all people.

KD: God wants me to pray for the needs of others.

PT: God calls Christians to tell people about Jesus and to teach them how to know and follow God.

MS: God values all people—born and unborn, young and old, male and female, and all ethnicities—and calls Christians to love people as God loves them.

HS: We are to be involved in reaching the nations, which includes those across the street and those around the world, through prayer, giving resources, loving actions, and sharing the gospel.

BEHAVIORS



What **BEHAVIORS** do we want kids and students to practice?

The role of spiritual disciplines in the life of a child or teenager significantly impact their spiritual development. Within each ministry area, the NextGen Ministry leaders will teach, equip, and model the following biblical disciplines. While the church will emphasize these, the desire is they become more than just ideas to know, but habits to form, understanding that doing them puts someone in a posture for growth.

- **BIBLE READING:** Regularly spends time reading the Bible and applying it to their life
- **PRAYER:** Regularly spends time talking with God by praising God, confessing sin, asking things of God, and listening to Him.
- **CORPORATE WORSHIP:** Regularly attends church worship to sing praises to God and hear the preaching of God's Word.
- **EVANGELISM:** Consistently looks for and acts upon opportunities to have Gospel conversations with others.
- **STEWARDSHIP & GIVING:** Regularly practices the discipline of tithing and generosity toward others.
- **OBEY GOD:** Strives to live in obedience to God, even when it's difficult.
- **CONNECT GROUP:** Regularly participates in a small group of believers for Bible study, fellowship, and accountability.
- **SERVICE:** Consistently looks for opportunities to serve the church, others, and the community.



NEXT STEP PARENT WORKSHOP: The years your child moves up into a new ministry phase is critical in the development of their faith and maturity. In order to help build bridges between the ministries and equip parents to be most effective in leading their child during that next phase, we created Next Step Parent Workshops. Each one will answer 5 specific questions and create a framework for the parent to be confident moving into this new season.

MINISTRY ON-RAMP: The earlier a child engages in a new ministry phase, the better. Because of that, each ministry has created a specific "Ministry On-Ramp" experience that is designed specifically for those transitioning into a ministry phase. Each On-Ramp experience is fun, energetic, and has the purpose of connecting the child or teen to other friends, leaders, and the ministry as a whole.

FAITH WALK:

Spontaneous opportunities to infuse faith into regular conversation with your children. Look for opportunities to turn a regular conversation into a faith conversation throughout your day as you walk with your children in life.

FAITH TALK:

An intentional conversation you have on a weekly basis with your children designed to infuse faith and teach them biblical truth that honors Christ. These conversations can happen around the dinner table, in the car on a drive, sitting in the living room, or in their room prior to going to bed. Utilize the questions provided to start the conversation and allow the Holy Spirit to lead you along the way. Utilize Scripture as often as possible.

- How can I pray for you this week?

- What has God taught you about Himself this week through church or your personal Bible study?
- What has God taught you about yourself this week through church or your personal Bible study?
- What is God asking you to do in response?
- How is your heart this week and how can I pray for you?

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
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
