Below are answers to some of the most frequently asked questions about the event.

Do I have to pre-register for the event? Can I register at the door/at the event?

There is no registration at the door/at the event. Everyone must pre-register. Registration closes on April 2 or when the capacity of 500 is reached.

What do I get for my registration fee?

- Everyone will receive a bag at the registration check-in desk that contains a printed event program, event nametag, a nametag holder, and additional materials provided by event partners.
- A box meal for Friday dinner and Saturday lunch.
 - Gluten-free option: indicate when registering for MGT how many in your group need gluten-free.
- Four General Sessions featuring worship, missionary testimonies, Bible study, and more.
- Six Breakout Sessions times covering various topics on missions, spiritual growth, mental health, and more.
- Connect with multiple ministries and organizations at the Missions Fair.

What if I register for the event and can't attend?

Your registration fee is non-refundable but is transferable to someone else.

Can I bring my daughter or other girls under age 18 with me to attend Missions Get-Together?

No. Missions Get-Together is an adult women's event for those 18 years and older.

Do you provide childcare?

No, childcare is not provided at Missions Get-Together.

What should I wear?

Wear comfortable clothing and shoes. We suggest layers.

Will coffee, other drinks, or snacks be available during the event?

- There will be a complimentary water and coffee station (no decaf coffee).
- There will be a WMU Café in the Missions Fair with snacks, bottled water, soda, and other beverages for \$1.00 each.

Friday morning hike/nature walk option

During the Friday morning Breakout Sessions, from 9:30 to 11:15 am, a group will walk/hike the nature trails at the nearby Montgomery Bell State Park. This will be a wonderful opportunity to see the spring wildflowers and enjoy nature with some other gals. Bug spray is recommended for both trails due to mosquitoes and ticks. Both options have roots and rocky areas, so hiking shoes with non-slip soles and a hiking stick are recommended.

Group 1 will do a 1-3 mile hike that is easy/moderate. Group 2 will do a 3-5 mile hike that is easy/moderate. We will begin together on a short nature trail close to the entrance, and one group will move over the trails more quickly while the other will follow at a more leisurely pace. There are sections with rocks and roots, so bring hiking shoes and a trekking pole (if desired). We will continue along the Ore Pit trail, which will lead us to an old church and home. The first group will have plenty of time to take in the sights and snap pictures along the way. We will then walk back along the road to our cars. This distance will be around 2-2.25 miles, but there are options to make it shorter if you prefer.

Those who want to continue hiking will walk beside a creek, through the woods, and along a lake. Waterproof shoes are recommended. This will be a faster moving group who

want a good workout in a beautiful setting. There will be options to walk back along the road at different points, so you can make the experience work best for you!

Both groups will meet at FBC Dickson at 9:30 am and carpool to the state park, since some trailheads have limited parking. You can bring a sandwich for lunch or grab something on the way back to the church.
