



Session Ten: Wise Choices Please God

Today's Point:

Wise choices honor God.

Bible Verse: Proverbs 8:33

CSB: "Listen to instruction and be wise; don't ignore it." Proverbs 8:33

KJV: "Hear instruction, and be wise, and refuse it not." Proverbs 8:33

Today's Bible Skill:

- Continue memorizing Proverbs 8:33
- Practice finding chapters and verses
- Understand that Proverbs teaches wisdom

Bible Truth Activity:

Game: Wise Choice or Foolish Choice

Object of the game:

Kids will learn how to make wise choices.

Directions:

Read different situations aloud. Kids will give a thumbs up for a wise choice and thumbs down for a foolish choice.

Examples:

- Sharing toys with a friend
- Hitting someone when angry
- Obeying parents
- Telling a lie
- Helping clean up
- Refusing to listen

After each example briefly discuss why the choice was wise or foolish.

When game is over say: Wise choices happen when we listen to good instruction.

The Bible says in Proverbs 8:33:

"Listen to instruction and be wise; don't ignore it."

God wants us to listen to His Word and obey Him because He loves us.

Ask:

- What is one wise choice you can make this week?
- Who helps teach you wise choices?

(Allow responses.)

Say:

When we listen to God and obey Him, we grow in wisdom.

Bible Verse Activity – March and Say

Help children find Proverbs 8:33.

Say:

We are going to march while we say our memory verse together.

March in place while repeating:

“Listen to instruction
and be wise;
don’t ignore it.
Proverbs 8:33”

Repeat:

- slowly
- quickly
- quietly
- loudly

Then challenge kids to say it from memory.

Bible Skills Activity: Chapter and Verse Hunt

Materials:

- Bible for each child

Instructions:

Review:

- Big numbers are chapters
- Small numbers are verses

Help children practice finding:

- Proverbs 8:33
- Psalm 54:2
- Deuteronomy 6:5

Allow kids to help one another find the verses.

After everyone finishes say:

The more we practice using our Bible, the easier it becomes to learn God's wisdom.
