



Session Eleven: Treat Others Kindly

Today's Point:

God wants us to treat others the way we want to be treated.

Bible Verse: Luke 6:31

CSB: "Just as you want others to do for you, do the same for them." Luke 6:31

KJV: "And as ye would that men should do to you, do ye also to them likewise." Luke 6:31

Today's Bible Skill:

- Begin to memorize Luke 6:31
- Know that Luke is in the New Testament
- Know that Luke is one of the four Gospels

Bible Truth Activity:

Game: Kindness Toss

Object of the game:

Kids will practice thinking of ways to show kindness to others.

Materials:

- Soft ball or beanbag

Directions:

Have children stand in a circle. Toss the ball to one child at a time. When a child catches the ball, they must name one kind thing they can do for someone else.

Examples:

- Help clean up
- Share a toy
- Say kind words
- Help a friend
- Pray for someone

Continue until every child has answered several times.

When activity is over say:

Jesus taught us to treat others kindly. In Luke 6:31 Jesus said:

"Just as you want others to do for you, do the same for them."

Ask:

- How do you like people to treat you?
- Do you like when people are kind?
- How can you show kindness this week?

(Allow responses.)

Say: Jesus wants us to show love and kindness to others every day.

Bible Verse Activity – Action Verse

Help children find Luke 6:31 in their Bible.

Read the verse together.

CSB:

“Just as you want others to do for you, do the same for them.” Luke 6:31

KJV:

“And as ye would that men should do to you, do ye also to them likewise.” Luke 6:31

Add motions:

- “Just as you want others” — point outward
- “to do for you” — point to self
- “do the same for them” — extend hands outward

Repeat the verse several times with motions.

Encourage kids to try saying it without help.

Bible Skills Activity: The Four Gospels

Materials:

- Bible for each child

Instructions:

Explain that Luke is one of the four Gospels.

Teach the names of the Gospels:

- Matthew
- Mark
- Luke
- John

Have children repeat the names several times together.

Practice finding Luke in the New Testament.

Help children locate:

- Luke chapter 6
- Verse 31

Conclude by saying:

The Gospels teach us about the life and teachings of Jesus.
