



Session Twelve: Use Loving Words

Today's Point:

God wants us to speak kindly to others.

Bible Verse: Luke 6:31

CSB: "Just as you want others to do for you, do the same for them." Luke 6:31

KJV: "And as ye would that men should do to you, do ye also to them likewise." Luke 6:31

Today's Bible Skill:

- Continue memorizing Luke 6:31
- Practice finding books in the New Testament
- Understand that Jesus taught people how to love others

Bible Trust Activity:

Game: Compliment Chain

Object of the game:

Kids will practice using kind and encouraging words.

Directions:

Have children sit in a circle. Choose one child to begin by saying something kind about another child.

Examples:

- "You are a good friend."
- "You share well."
- "You are helpful."

The next child gives a compliment to someone else until everyone has participated.

When game is over say: Words can help people feel loved and encouraged. Jesus wants us to treat people the way we want to be treated.

Luke 6:31 says: "Just as you want others to do for you, do the same for them."

Ask:

- How do you feel when someone says something kind to you?
- What are some kind words you can use this week?

(Allow responses.)

Say: Our words should show the love of Jesus.

Bible Verse Activity – Erase the Words

Write the verse on a whiteboard or large paper.

Read the verse together several times.

Erase a few words and have children say the verse again.

Continue erasing more words until children can say most of the verse from memory.

Repeat using either the CSB and KJV versions.

Bible Skills Activity: New Testament Practice

Materials:

- Bible for each child

Instructions:

Explain that the New Testament begins with the four Gospels.

Help children practice finding:

- Matthew
- Mark
- Luke
- John

Then help them find Luke 6:31 several times.

Review:

- Big numbers are chapters
- Small numbers are verses

Conclude by saying:

God gave us the Bible so we can learn how to live for Him.
