



Session Five: BIBLE SKILL NIGHT

Today's Bible Skill:

- Review Bible Verses
- Review Bible Skills

Divide Group into 4 Teams – Each team will rotate through Bible Skills stations.

Bible Skill Station One: Bible Verse Review

Bible Verse Activity: Unscramble Bible Verse

Materials:

Large craft sticks, one word per stick, two different colored markers
Cardstock

Preparation:

Print each word of Leviticus 22:31 and Deuteronomy 6:5 on a craft stick. Use a different color for each verse.
Prepare 5 sets.
Print Leviticus 22:31 on a piece of cardstock
Print Deuteronomy 6:5 on a piece of cardstock

Instructions:

Give each child or each group a set of craft sticks
Place printed verse in eyesight
Instruct players to separate verses and place them in order.
If time permits, let them put verses together again to see which group/child can do it the quickest.

Bible Skills Station Two: Pass the Marble

Materials:

Bible – one for each group
Paper towel roll – one for each child
Marble – one per group
Books of the Bible Flashcards – two sets per group – use Books of History cards

Instructions:

Review: The books in the Old Testament are part of a division. In the Old Testament the Divisions are (bring attention to the division signs from last week): Law, History, Poetry, Major Prophets, and Minor Prophets.
The Division of Law has 5 books – Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy

Lead kids to form a circle of five or less. Give each child a paper towel roll. Place a marble inside the first kid's tube and challenge her to roll the marble carefully to the player on her right while saying the first book of the Old Testament Books of Law (Genesis). The next player transfers the marble to the next player's tube while saying the next book (Exodus). The goal is to transfer the marble saying all five books at least twice, without dropping it. If a player drops the marble, the next player should begin with Genesis again.

Bible Skills Station Three: Books of the Bible Card Toss

Materials:

Bible
Buckets (2) – label one Old Testament, one New Testament
Books of the Bible Flashcard Set
Masking tape

Preparation:

Place a masking tape “Start” line on the floor about 2 feet from the buckets. Place cards on start line.

Instructions:

Explain that each book of the Bible is either located in the Old Testament or the New Testament. The purpose of this game is to get each card in the correct bucket. To do so you must decide if the book is in the Old Testament or the New Testament.

Line group up single file, behind the “start” line. When given the signal to start – the first team member is to pick up the first card in the deck, toss the card into the correct bucket (OT or NT) and go to the back of the line. This continues until all books are placed in buckets.

Have each group use the Table of Content of the Bible to check their group’s accuracy.

OPTION:

For your younger kids, ask an adult volunteer to help child locate book on Table of Contents.

Bible Skills Station Four: Old Testament Divisions

Materials:

Bible – one for each group
Balloon – one for every two people (be sure no child has a latex allergy)
Paper Plates – one per person
Paint Stir Stick – one per person

Instructions:

Explain that the books in the Old Testament are part of a division. In the Old Testament the Divisions are (bring attention to the division signs from last week): Law, History, Poetry, Major Prophets, and Minor Prophets.

The Division of Law has 5 Books – Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy

Divide groups into pairs. Give each kid a paddle and each pair a balloon.

Have kids face each other – about 2 feet apart.

As they bat balloon back and forth, they will repeat books of Law.

Repeat adding Books of History.
