Welcome to _____ (Church) Bible Drill. My name is _____.
I will be your Caller today. We are here to rejoice in the fact that these children have desired to worship and honor God by hiding His Word in their heart.

Thank you, parents, for encouraging and supporting your children. We know today is a special day for them and your family. Let me remind you that during the drill you may not be able to hear everything I say because my back will be to you. The children will be asked to keep their eyes on me. They may glance at you so be sure to keep a smile on your face to encourage them.

A special thank you to our judges and timekeeper. (Introduce them.)

To help us have a good day, let's go over the Rules of the Room. It is vital that you do the following:

- No picture taking *during* the Drill. We allow time for pictures after the Drill. Also, for the safety of all our drillers video recording will not be allowed during our drill.
- If you leave the room for any reason, do not re-enter the room.
- Place everything in your hands under your chair at this time. (Pause and watch while they do it.)
- Help us eliminate distractions such as turning off cell phones, electronic games, and devices. Please turn them off now. (Pause while they do it.)
- Remain as quiet as possible, with no prompting from the audience. If a young child becomes distracting, then please leave the room as quickly and quietly as possible until the Drill is complete.

Turn towards the Children.

Girls and boys, now I want to remind you:

- Keep your hands at your side until I say "attention."
- Your eyes are to stay on me until I say "start."
- Do not step out if you don't know the answer.
- Place your index finger on your Bible before stepping out.
- If you start forward when "time" is called, come on out. Let the judges decide if you "beat the clock."
- If you step forward, don't go back. If you stepped forward mistakenly, please raise your hand.
- If you are called upon, take one step forward to answer. After answering step back.
- Treat your Bible with respect.

One last thing: Remember if you make a mistake while answering I will give you an opportunity to correct it. After that, I will call on a 2nd child and if also missed, then I will give the correct response and move on.

Are there any questions? Let's start with a word of prayer. (Pray.)

We will begin each section with a practice call. These do not count for or against you.

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- I. Our first section will be the “Book Call”. I will give the name of a book in the Bible and you will find the book. Place a finger on any verse in the book named and step forward. If I call your number, you will *step forward and* say the book *before* the one named, the book named and the book that *follows*. Our first call will be a practice call.**

Practice Call:

Attention.

Present Bibles.

JOSHUA. *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: Deuteronomy – JOSHUA – Judges

Judges and children, we now begin the Book Drill.

1. Attention.

Present Bibles.

MARK *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: Matthew – MARK – Luke

2. Attention.

Present Bibles.

ACTS. *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: John – ACTS – Romans

3. Attention.

Present Bibles.

1 KINGS *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: 2 Samuel – 1 KINGS – 2 Kings

4. Attention.

Present Bibles.

NEHEMIAH. *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: Ezra – NEHEMIAH – Esther

5. Attention.

Present Bibles.

JOHN. *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: Luke – JOHN – Acts

6. Attention.

Present Bibles.

PROVERBS *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: Psalms – PROVERBS – Ecclesiastes

This ends the Book Drill.

Optional Book Calls

Attention.

Present Bibles.

RUTH *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: Judges – RUTH – 1 Samuel

Attention

Present Bibles.

ROMANS *(pause)*

Start *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: Acts – ROMANS – 1 Corinthians

II. We will now have the “Key Passage Drill”. I will give the title of a key passage. You will find the passage, place a finger on any verse in the passage, and step forward. If called upon, I will ask you to state the key passage title, the reference, and will ask you to read a verse within that passage. Our first call will be a practice call.

Practice Call:

Attention.

Present Bibles.

A Prayer for Forgiveness (*pause*)

Start. (*Call on a child after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER: A Prayer for Forgiveness / Psalm 51

Please read verse 10.

KJV – Psalm 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.

CSB – Psalm 51:10 God, create a clean heart for me and renew a steadfast spirit within me.

Judges and children, we now begin the Key Passage Drill.

1. Attention.

Present Bibles.

The Birth of Jesus (*pause*)

Start. (*Call on a child after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER: The Birth of Jesus / Luke 2:1-7

Please read verse 7.

KJV – Luke 2:7 And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn.

CSB – Luke 2:7 Then she gave birth to her firstborn Son, and she wrapped him tightly in cloth and laid him in a manger, because there was no guest room available for them.

2. Attention.

Present Bibles.

The Baptism of Jesus (*pause*)

Start. (*Call on a child after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER: The Baptism of Jesus / Matthew 3:13-17

Please read verse 13

KJV – Matthew 3:13 Then cometh Jesus from Galilee to Jordan unto John, to be baptized of him.

CSB – Matthew 3:13 Then Jesus came from Galilee to John at the Jordan, to be baptized by him.

3. Attention.

Present Bibles.

The Christian’s Armor (*pause*)

Start. (*Call on a child after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER: The Christian’s Armor / Ephesians 6:10-20. PAGE TURN IS ACCEPTABLE IN KJV

Please read verse 11.

KJV – Ephesians 6:11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

CSB – Ephesians 6:11 Put on the full armor of God so that you can stand against the schemes of the devil.

4. Attention.

Present Bibles.

The Creation (*pause*)

Start. (*Call on a child after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER: The Creation / Genesis 1 – 2:3. PAGE TURN IS ACCEPTABLE IN KJV & CSB

Please read Chapter 1, verse 3.

KJV – Genesis 1:3. And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.

CSB - Genesis 1:3 Then God said, “Let there be light,” and there was light.

Continues >>>>

5. Attention.

Present Bibles.

The Comfort Chapter (*pause*)

Start. (*Call on a child after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER: The Comfort Chapter / John 14

Please read verse 13.

KJV – John 14:13 And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

CSB – John 14:13 Whatsoever you ask in my name, I will do it so that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

6. Attention.

Present Bibles.

The Great Commandments (*pause*)

Start. (*Call on a child after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER: The Great Commandments / Mark 12:28-34

Please read verse 33.

KJV – Mark 12:33 And to love him with all the heart, with all the understanding, and with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love his neighbor as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices.

CSB - Mark 12:33 And to love him with all your heart, with all your understanding, and with all your strength, and to love your neighbor as yourself, is far more important than all the burnt offerings and sacrifices.”

This ends the Key Passage Drill.

Optional Key Passage Calls

Attention.

Present Bibles.

The Israelites Leave Egypt (*pause*)

Start. (*Call on a child after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER: The Israelites Leave Egypt / Exodus 12:37-42

Please read verse 40.

KJV – Exodus 12:40 Now the sojourning of the children of Israel, who dwelt in Egypt, *was* four

hundred and thirty years.

CSB – Exodus 12:40 The time that the Israelites lived in Egypt was 430 years.

III. We will now have the Quotation Drill. You may place your Bibles on the floor behind you OR continue to hold your Bibles. I will give the reference of a verse. If you know the verse, step forward, and when called upon quote the verse and reference. Please speak slowly and clearly, so that the Judges and I can hear you correctly. We will begin with a practice call.

Practice Call:

Attention.

Proverbs 20:11 (*pause*)

Start. (*Call on child after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER:

KJV - Even a child is known by his doings, whether his work be pure, and whether it be right. Proverbs 20:11

CSB – Even a young man is known by his actions – by whether his behavior is pure and upright. Proverbs 20:11

Continues >>>>

Judges and children, we will now begin the Quotation Drill.

1. Attention.

Acts 1:8 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV - But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth. Acts 1:8

CSB - But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come on you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end (ends) of the earth. Acts 1:8

2. Attention.

Matthew 5:44 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV - But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you. Matthew 5:44

CSB - But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you. Matthew 5:44.

3. Attention.

Ephesians 6:1 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV - Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right. Ephesians 6:1

CSB – Children, obey your parents in the Lord, because this is right. Ephesians 6:1

Continues >>>>

4. Attention.

John 15:13 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

**KJV - Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.
John 15:13**

CSB - No one has greater love than this: to lay down his life for his friends. John 15:13

5. Attention.

Luke 6:31 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV - And as ye would that men should do to you, do ye also to them likewise. Luke 6:31

CSB - Just as you want others to do for you, do the same for them. Luke 6:31

6. Attention

Leviticus 22:31 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV - Therefore shall ye keep my commandments, and do them: I am the LORD. Leviticus 22:31

CSB - You are to keep my commands and do them; I am the LORD. Leviticus 22:31

This ends the Quotation Drill

Continues >>>>

Optional Quotation Calls:

Attention.

Psalm 54:2 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV - Hear my prayer, O God; give ear to the words of my mouth. Psalm 54:2

CSB - God, hear my prayer; listen to the words from my mouth. Psalm 54:2

IV. We will now have the Completion Drill. I will give you a portion of a verse of Scripture. If you know the entire verse and where it is found, step forward. When called upon, recite the entire verse and the reference. The first call will be a Practice Call.

(Note to Caller: When using more than one version, say: “Some of you are using different versions of the Bible. I will name the version and the portion of the verse for each version represented. If I call on you during the drill for the correct response, you may ask me to repeat the verse again.”)

Practice Call:

Attention.

KJV - Let the words of my mouth, ... *(pause)*

CSB - May the words of my mouth ... *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV - Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O Lord, my strength, and my redeemer. Psalm 19:14

CSB – May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable to you, Lord, my rock and my Redeemer. Psalm 19:14

Continues >>>>

Judges and Children, we will now begin the Completion Drill.

1. Attention.

KJV - Heaven and earth shall pass ... (pause)

CSB - Heaven and earth will pass ... (pause)

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV - Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away. Mark 13:31

CSB – Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away. Mark 13:31

2. Attention.

KJV - Wherefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be, ... (pause)

CSB - My dear brothers and sisters, understand this: Everyone should be ... (pause)

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV - Wherefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath: James 1:19

CSB - My dear brothers and sisters, understand this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to anger. James 1:19

3. Attention.

KJV - The Lord is good to all: ... (pause)

CSB - The Lord is good to everyone; ... (pause)

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV - The Lord is good to all: and his tender mercies are over all his works. Psalm 145:9

CSB - The Lord is good to everyone; his compassion rests on all he has made. Psalm 145:9

Continues >>>>

4. Attention.

KJV - So then every one of us... (pause)

CSB - So then, each of us... (pause)

Start. (Call on a child after "time" has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV - So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God. Romans 14:12

CSB - So then, each of us will give an account of himself to God. Romans 14:12

5. Attention.

KJV - He hath shewed thee, O man, what is good; ... (pause)

CSB - Mankind, he has told each of you what is good ... (pause)

Start. (Call on a child after "time" has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV - He hath shewed thee, O man, what is good; and what doth the Lord require of thee, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy God? Micah 6:8

CSB - Mankind, he has told each of you what is good and what it is the Lord requires of you: to act justly, to love faithfulness, and to walk humbly with your God. Micah 6:8

6. Attention.

KJV - Whether therefore ye eat, ... (pause)

CSB - So, whether you eat ... (pause)

Start. (Call on a child after "time" has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV - Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God. 1 Corinthians 10:31

CSB - So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do everything for the glory of God. 1 Corinthians 10:31

We have now completed the Completion Drill.

Optional Completion Drill

Attention.

KJV - Hearken unto this, O Job:... *(pause)*

CSB - Listen to this, Job.... *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a child after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

**KJV - Hearken unto this, O Job: stand still, and consider the wondrous works of God.
Job 37:14**

CSB - Listen to this, Job. Stop and consider God’s wonders. Job 37:14

We are finished! Thank you, boys and girls for doing such a wonderful job. Our judges will now leave to tally the results of our Drill. Parents, at this time it will be fine to take pictures. While our Judges are getting the results together, we will say the Books of the Bible. Number one, will you begin please?

(You may use this time in several ways. Testimonies by drillers of what Bible Drill means to them or sharing a fun time their Bible Drill has shared together are some possibilities as you wait for the Judges to return.)
