



High School Bible Drill 2027

Abbreviated Church Drill

Red Cycle

- A caller will call only the King James Version of the calls, if all drillers are using the KJV
- A caller will call only the Christian Standard Bible version of the calls, if all drillers are using the CSB
- The caller will need to call KJV and CSB calls if all translations are being used in a drill.
- For practice sessions, callers can quickly change up the Book Drill & the Scripture Searching drill on their own to give it variety.
- For additional drills:
 - Steps to Salvation* drill include all 6 verses.
 - What We Believe* drill would be the other 5 verses not on the Practice Drill.
 - Key Biblical Passages* drill would be the other 3 verses not on the Practice Drill.

Welcome to _____(Church) Bible Drill. My name is _____. I will be your Caller today. We are here to rejoice in the fact that these students have desired to worship and honor God by hiding His Word in their heart. Thank you, parents, for encouraging and supporting your students. We know today is a special day for them and for you as well.

A special thank you to our judges and timekeeper. (Introduce them.)

To help us have a good day, let's go over the Rules of the Room. It is vital that you do the following:

- No picture taking *during* the Drill. We allow time for pictures after the Drill. Also, for the safety of all our drillers video recording will not be allowed during our drill.
- If you leave the room for any reason, do not re-enter the room.
- Place everything in your hands under your chair at this time. (Pause and watch while they do it.)
- Help us eliminate distractions such as turning off cell phones, electronic games, and devices. Please turn them off now. (Pause while they do it.)
- Remain as quiet as possible, with no prompting from the audience. If a young child becomes distracting, then please leave the room as quickly and quietly as possible until the Drill is complete.

Turn towards the Students.

Students, I want to remind you:

- Keep your hands at your side until I say "attention."
- Your eyes are to stay on me until I say "start."
- Do not step out if you don't know the answer.
- Place your index finger on your Bible before stepping out.

- If you start forward when “time” is called, come on out. Let the judges decide if you “beat the clock.”
- If you step forward, don’t go back. If you stepped forward mistakenly, please raise your hand.
- If you are called upon, take one step forward to answer. After answering step back.
- Treat your Bible with respect.

Are there any questions? (Allow time for questions)

Let’s start with a word of prayer. (Pray.)

We will begin our drill.

BOOK DRILL- 3 calls

*I will call the name of a book. You will locate the book, place your index finger on any verse in that book and step forward. When called upon, you will **(take one step forward and)** name the book before, the book called, and the book that follows.*

1. Attention – Present Bibles – **JUDE** – Start
(3 John – JUDE – Revelation)
2. Attention – Present Bibles – **JOHN** – Start
(Luke – JOHN – Acts)
3. Attention – Present Bibles – **LAMENTATIONS** – Start
(Jeremiah– LAMENTATIONS – Ezekiel)

Extra: Attention – Present Bibles – **HEBREWS** – Start
(Philemon – HEBREWS – James)

SCRIPTURE SEARCHING DRILL- 3 Calls

I will call a Scripture verse. You will locate the verse, place your index finger on the verse and step forward. When called upon, you will **(take one step forward and)** read the verse and give the Scripture reference.

1. Attention – Present Bibles – 2 SAMUEL 22:47 – Start

KJV - The Lord liveth; and blessed by my rock; and exalted be the God of the rock of my salvation.
(2 Samuel 22:47)

CSB - The Lord lives – blessed be my rock! God, the rock of my salvation, is exalted.
(2 Samuel 22:47)

2. Attention – Present Bibles – 1 TIMOTHY 1:12 – Start

KJV - And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry; (1 Timothy 1:12)

CSB - I give thanks to Christ Jesus our Lord who has strengthened me, because he considered me faithful, appointing me to the ministry – (1 Timothy 1:12)

3. Attention – Present Bibles – JOSHUA 23:11 – Start

KJV - Take good heed therefore unto yourselves, that ye love the LORD your God. (Joshua 23:11)

CSB - So diligently watch yourselves! Love the LORD your God. (Joshua 23:11)

EXTRA: Attention – Present Bibles – GALATIANS 5:16-17 – Start

KJV - This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would. (Galatians 5:16-17)

CSB - I say then, walk by the Spirit and you will certainly not carry out the desire of the flesh. For the flesh desires what is against the Spirit, and the Spirit desires what is against the flesh; these are opposed to each other, so that you don't do what you want. (Galatians 5:16-17)

STEPS TO SALVATION DRILL – 3 Calls

*I will quote a reference of a verse listed in the Steps to Salvation Drill. Each of the references of the six verses will be called out in the order listed on your card. You will locate the verse in your Bible; place your index finger on the verse before you step forward. When time is called, I will instruct you to close your Bibles. If called upon, you will (**take one step forward and**) recite the entire verse and give the scripture reference. (I will give the KJV first, and the CSB last.)*

1. Attention – Present Bibles – ROMANS 3:23 – Start—Close your Bibles

KJV - For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; (Romans 3:23)

CSB - For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. (Romans 3:23)

2. Attention – Present Bibles – ROMANS 6:23 – Start—(Close your Bibles)

KJV - For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
(Romans 6:23)

CSB - For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
(Romans 6:23)

3. Attention – Present Bibles – ROMANS 10:9-10 – Start—(Close your Bibles)

KJV - That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. (Romans 10:9-10)

CSB - If you confess with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. One believes with the heart, resulting in righteousness, and one confesses with the mouth, resulting in salvation. (Romans 10:9-10)

EXTRA: Attention -Present Bibles – ROMANS 10:13 – Start—(Close your Bibles)

KJV - For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. (Romans 10:13)

CSB - For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. (Romans 10:13)

WHAT WE BELIEVE DRILL – 3 Calls

I will announce a question from the section of the verse card entitled “What We Believe.” You must correctly locate the verse listed that answers the What We Believe question and place your index finger on the verse before you step forward. When time is called, I will instruct you to close your Bibles. When called upon, you must ***(take one step forward and)*** recite the question, quote the verse word for word, and state the Scripture reference.

1. Attention – Present Bibles – **WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT WHAT I CAN OFFER GOD?** – Start— (Close your Bibles)

KJV - I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies
a living
sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not
conformed to this
world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is
that good,
and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. (Romans 12:1-2)

CSB - Therefore, brothers and sisters, in view of the mercies of God, I urge you to present
your bodies as a
living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God; this is your true worship. Do not be
conformed to this age, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you
may discern what is the good, pleasing, and perfect will of God. (Romans 12:1-2)

2. Attention – Present Bibles – **WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT THE SABBATH?** – Start
(Close your Bibles)

KJV - And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the
seventh day
from all his work which he had made. And God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified
it: because
that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made. (Genesis 2:2-3)

CSB - On the seventh day God had completed his work that he had done, and he rested on
the seventh day
from all his work that he had done. God blessed the seventh day and declared it holy,
for on it he
rested from all his work of creation. (Genesis 2: 2-3)

3. Attention – Present Bibles – **WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT THE ONE TRUE GOD?** –
Start
(Close your Bibles)

KJV - But the LORD is the true God, he is the living God, and an everlasting king: at his wrath the earth shall tremble, and the nations shall not be able to abide his indignation. (Jeremiah 10:10)

CSB - But the LORD is the true God; he is the living God and eternal King. The earth quakes at his wrath, and the nations cannot endure his rage. (Jeremiah 10:10)

EXTRA: Attention – Present Bibles – WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT CHRISTIANS CHANGING

THE WORLD? – Start (Close your Bibles)

KJV - Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? It is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men. Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven. Matthew 5:13-16

CSB - “You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt should lose its taste, how can it be made salty? It’s no longer good for anything but to be thrown out and trampled under people’s feet. “You are the light of the world. A city situated on a hill cannot be hidden. No one lights a lamp and puts it under a basket, but rather on a lampstand, and it gives light for all who are in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven. Matthew 5:13-16.

KEY BIBLICAL PASSAGES DRILL – 2 Calls

I will announce a Key Biblical Passage Title taken from this section of verses on your card. Before you step forward, you must correctly locate the passage listed with the Key Biblical Passage on the card. When time is called, I will instruct you to close your Bible. When called upon, you must be able to give the (1) Key Biblical Passage Title, (2) correctly quote word for word the portion of scripture related to the Key Biblical Passage and (3) recite the correct scripture reference that is associated with that Key Biblical Passage.

1. Attention – Present Bibles – A SHEPHERD’S PSALM (PSALM 23) – Start (Close your Bibles.)

KJV - A Shepherd’s Psalm (Psalm 23)

The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters. He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name’s sake. Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me. Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD for ever.
(Psalm 23)

CSB - A Shepherd’s Psalm (Psalm 23)

The Lord is my shepherd; I have what I need. He lets me lie down in green pastures; he leads me beside quiet waters. He renews my life; he leads me along the right paths for his name’s sake. Even when I go through the darkest valley, I fear no danger for you are with me; your rod and your staff – they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. Only goodness and faithful love will pursue me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the LORD as long as I live. (Psalm 23)

2. Attention – Present Bibles – **THE WAY I SHOULD ACT (1 TIMOTHY 4: 11-16)** – Start (Close your Bibles)

KJV - The Way I Should Act (1 Timothy 4:11-16)

These things command and teach. Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity. Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine. Neglect not the gift that is in thee, which was given thee by prophecy, with the laying on of the hands of the presbytery. Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all. Take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine; continue in them: for in doing this thou shalt both save thyself, and them that hear thee. (1 Timothy 4:11-16)

CSB - The Way I Should Act (1 Timothy 4:11-16)

Command and teach these things. Don't let anyone despise your youth, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, and in purity. Until I come, give your attention to public reading, exhortation, and teaching. Don't neglect the gift that is in you; it was given to you through prophecy, with the laying on of hands by the council of elders. Practice these things; be committed to them, so that your progress may be evident to all. Pay close attention to your life and your teaching; persevere in these things, for in doing this you will save both yourself and your hearers. (1 Timothy 4:11-16)

- Extra: Attention – Present Bibles – **THE TEN COMMANDMENTS (EXODUS 20:3-17)** – Start (Close your Bibles)

KJV - The Ten Commandments (Exodus 20:3-17)

Thou shalt have no other gods before me. Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them :for I the Lord thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments. Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain; for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: but the seventh day is the sabbath of the Lord thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day, and hallowed it. Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee. Thou shalt not kill. Thou shalt not commit adultery. Thou shalt not steal. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's. (Exodus 20: 3-17)

CSB - The Ten Commandments (Exodus 20:3-17)

Do not have other gods besides me. Do not make an idol for yourself, whether in the shape of anything in the heavens above or on the earth below or in the waters under the earth. Do not bow in worship to them, and do not serve them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the fathers' iniquity, to the third and fourth generations of those who hate me, but showing faithful love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commands. Do not misuse the name of the LORD your God, because the LORD will not leave anyone unpunished who misuses his name. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy: You are to labor six days and do all your work, but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. You must not do any work - you, your son or daughter, your male or female servant, your livestock, or the resident alien who is within your city gates. For the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and everything in them in six days; then he rested on the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and declared it holy. Honor your father and your mother so that you may have a long life in the land that the LORD your God is giving you. Do not murder. Do not commit adultery. Do not steal. Do not give false testimony against your neighbor. Do not covet your neighbor's house. Do not covet your neighbor's wife, his male or female servant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor. (Exodus 20:3-17)
