Red Cycle

- A caller will call only the King James Version of the calls, if all drillers are using the KJV
- A caller will call only the Christian Standard Bible Version of the calls, if all drillers are using the CSB
- The caller will need to call KJV and CSB calls if all translations are being used in a drill.
- For practice sessions, callers can quickly change up the Book Drill & the Scripture Searching drill on their own to give it variety.
- For additional drills:
 - Steps to Salvation* drill include all 6 verses.
 - What We Believe* drill would be the other 5 verses not on the Practice Drill.
 - Key Biblical Passages* drill would be the other 3 verses not on the Practice Drill.

Welcome to _____ (Church) High School Bible Drill. My name is _____. I will be your Caller today. We are here to rejoice in the fact that these students have desired to worship and honor God by hiding His Word in their heart. Thank you, parents, for encouraging and supporting your students. We know today is a special day for them and for you as well.

A special thank you to our judges and timekeeper. (Introduce them.)

To help us have a good day, let's go over the Rules of the Room. It is vital that you do the following:

- No picture taking *during* the Drill. We allow time for pictures after the Drill. Also, for the safety of all our drillers video recording will not be allowed during our drill.
- If you leave the room for any reason, do not re-enter the room.
- Place everything in your hands under your chair at this time. (Pause and watch while they do it.)
- Help us eliminate distractions such as turning off cell phones, electronic games, and devices. Please turn them off now. (Pause while they do it.)
- Remain as quiet as possible, with no prompting from the audience. If a young child becomes distracting, then please leave the room as quickly and quietly as possible until the Drill is complete.

Turn towards the Students.

Students, I want to remind you:

- Keep your hands at your side until I say “attention.”
- Your eyes are to stay on me until I say “start.”
- Do not step out if you don’t know the answer.
- Place your index finger on your Bible before stepping out.
- If you start forward when “time” is called, come on out. Let the judges decide if you “beat the clock.”
- If you step forward, don’t go back. If you stepped forward mistakenly, please raise your hand.
- Treat your Bible with respect.

Are there any questions? (Allow time for questions)

Let’s start with a word of prayer. (Pray.)

We will begin our drill.

BOOK DRILL – 5 Calls

Our first section will be the “Book Drill”. I will call the name of a book in the Bible. You will locate the book, place your index finger on any verse in that book and step forward. When called upon, you will name the book before, the book called, and the book that follows.

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1. Attention

Present Bibles.

DANIEL (pause)

Start. (Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER: Ezekiel – DANIEL – Hosea

2. Attention

Present Bibles.

JOHN (pause)

Start. (Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER: Luke – JOHN – Acts

3. Attention

Present Bibles.

1 KINGS (pause)

Start. (Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER: 2 Samuel – 1 KINGS – 2 Kings

4. Attention

Present Bibles.

JUDE *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: 3 John – JUDE – Revelation

5. Attention

Present Bibles.

EZRA *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: 2 Chronicles – EZRA – Nehemiah

This ends the Book Drill.

Extra Book Drill call if needed:

HEBREWS *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER: Philemon – HEBREWS – James

SCRIPTURE SEARCHING DRILL – 5 Calls

We will now begin the “Scripture Searching Drill”. I will call a Scripture verse. You will locate the verse, place your index finger on the verse and step forward. When called upon, you will read the verse and give the Scripture reference.

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1. Attention

Present Bibles

JAMES 1:22 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV – But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.
James 1:22

CSB – But be doers of the word and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. James 1:22

2. Attention

Present Bibles

Joshua 1:9 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV – Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid,
neither be thou
dismayed: for the Lord thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest. Joshua 1:9

CSB – Haven’t I commanded you: be strong and courageous? Do not be afraid or
discouraged, for the
Lord your God is with you wherever you go.” Joshua 1:9

3. Attention

Present Bibles

JOHN 17:4 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV – I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest
me to do.
John 17:4

CSB – I have glorified you on the earth by completing the work you gave me to do.
John 17:4

4. Attention

Present Bibles

Psalms 119:105 (pause)

Start. (Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV – Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path. Psalm 119:105

CSB – Your word is a lamp for my feet and a light on my path. Psalm 119:105

5. Attention

Present Bibles

Isaiah 55:6 (pause)

Start. (Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV – Seek ye the Lord while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near.
Isaiah 55:6

CSB – Seek the Lord while he may be found; call to him while he is near. Isaiah 55:6

This ends the Scripture Searching Drill.

Extra Scripture Searching call if needed:

Present Bibles

Revelation 3:20 (pause)

Start. (Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)

ANSWER:

KJV – Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me. Revelation 3:20

CSB – See! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me. Revelation 3:20

STEPS TO SALVATION DRILL – 6 Calls

We will now begin the Steps to Salvation Drill. I will call a reference of a verse listed in the Steps to Salvation section of your verse card. Each of the six verses will be called out in the order listed on your card. You will locate the verse in your Bible; place your index finger on the verse, and then step forward. When time is called, I will instruct you to close your Bibles. If called upon, you will recite the entire verse and give the scripture reference.

1. Attention

Present Bibles

Romans 3:10 (*Pause*)

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV – As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one: Romans 3:10

CSB – as it is written: There is no one righteous, not even one. Romans 3:10

2. Attention

Present Bibles

Romans 3:23 (*Pause*)

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV – For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; Romans 3:23

CSB – For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. Romans 3:23

3. Attention

Present Bibles

Romans 5:8 (*Pause*)

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV – But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:8

CSB – But God proves his own love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:8

4. Attention

Present Bibles

Romans 6:23 (*Pause*)

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV – For the wages of sin *is* death; but the gift of God *is* eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. Romans 6:23

CSB – For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
Romans 6:23

5. Attention

Present Bibles

Romans 10:9-10 (*Pause*)

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV – That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. Romans 10:9-10

CSB – If you confess with your mouth, “Jesus in Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. One believes with the heart, resulting in righteousness, and one confesses with the mouth, resulting in salvation. Romans 10:9-10

6. Attention

Present Bibles

Romans 10:13 (*Pause*)

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV – For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. Romans 10:13

CSB – For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. Romans 10:9-10

This ends the Steps to Salvation Drill.

WHAT WE BELIEVE DRILL – 5 Calls

We will now begin the “What We Believe Drill”. I will announce a question from the section of the verse card entitled “What We Believe.” You must correctly locate the verse listed that answers the What We Believe question and place your index finger on the verse before you step forward. When time is called, I will instruct you to close your Bibles. If called upon, you must recite the question, quote the verse word for word, and state the Scripture reference.

1. Attention

Present Bibles

WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT OUR FUTURE? *(Pause)*

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV – For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the Lord, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end. Jeremiah 29:11

CSB – For I know the plans I have for you” – this is the LORD’S declaration – “plans for your well-being, not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope. Jeremiah 29:11

WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT LEARNING GOD’S WORD? *(Pause)*

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV— Therefore shall ye lay up these my words in your heart and in your soul, and bind them for a sign upon your hand, that they may be as frontlets between your eyes. And ye shall teach them your children, speaking of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, when thou liest down, and when thou risest up. Deuteronomy 11:18-19

CSB — “Imprint these words of mine on your hearts and minds, bind them as a sign on your hands, and let them be a symbol on your foreheads. Teach them to your children, talking about them when you sit in your house and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Deuteronomy 11:18-19

3. Attention

Present Bibles

WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT WHAT I CAN OFFER GOD? *(Pause)*

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV – I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. Romans 12:1-2

CSB – Therefore, brothers and sisters, in view of the mercies of God, I urge you to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God; this is your true worship. Do not be conformed to this age, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may discern what is the good, pleasing, and perfect will of God. Romans 12:1-2

4. Attention

Present Bibles

WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT WHAT BELONGS TO THE LORD? *(Pause)*

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV – And all the tithe of the land, whether of the seed of the land, or of the fruit of the tree, is the Lord's: it is holy unto the Lord. Leviticus 27:30

CSB – “Every tenth of the land’s produce, grain from the soil or fruit from the trees, belongs to the LORD; it is holy to the LORD. Leviticus 27:30

5. Attention

Present Bibles

WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT GOD HEARING US? *(Pause)*

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV – I love the Lord, because he hath heard my voice and my supplications. Because he hath inclined his ear unto me, therefore will I call upon him as long as I live. Psalms 116:1-2

CSB – I love the LORD because he has heard my appeal for mercy. Because he has turned his ear to me, I will call out to him as long as I live. Psalm 116:1-2

This ends the What We Believe Drill.

Extra What We Believe Drill call if needed:

Present Bibles

WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT WHO WILL NOT INHERIT THE KINGDOM OF GOD? (Pause)

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV – Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolators, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God. 1 Corinthians 6:9-10

CSB – Don't you know that the unrighteous will not inherit God's kingdom? Do not be deceived: No sexually immoral people, idolaters, adulterers, or males who have sex with males, no thieves, greedy people, drunkards, verbally abusive people, or swindlers will inherit God's kingdom. 1 Corinthians 6:9-10

KEY BIBLICAL PASSAGES DRILL – 3 Calls

We will now begin the “Key Biblical Passages Drill”. I will announce a Key Biblical Passage Title from the Key

Passage section on your verse card. Before you step forward, you must correctly locate the passage listed with the

Key Passage on the card, and place your index finger on any verse in the passage. When time is called, I will

instruct you to close your Bible. When called upon, you must give the (1) Key Biblical Passage Title, (2) correctly

quote word for word the portion of scripture related to the Key Biblical Passage, and (3) recite the correct scripture

reference that is associated with that Key Passage.

1. Attention

Present Bibles

A Shepherd's Psalm (*Pause*)

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV – A Shepherd's Psalm (Psalm 23) THE Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters. He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake. Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me. Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the Lord for ever. Psalm 23

CSB – A Shepherd's Psalm (Psalm 23) The Lord is my shepherd; I have what I need. He lets me lie down in green pastures; he leads me beside quiet waters. He renews my life; he leads me along the right paths for his name's sake. Even when I go through the darkest valley, I fear no danger, for you are with me; your rod and your staff – they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. Only goodness and faithful love will pursue me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord as long as I live. Psalm 23

2. Attention

Present Bibles

MIND OF CHRIST (*Pause*)

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV – Mind of Christ (Philippians 2:5-11) Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of *things* in heaven, and *things* in earth, and *things* under the earth; And *that* every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ *is* Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
Philippians 2:5-11

CSB – Mind of Christ (Philippians 2:5-11) Adopt the same attitude as that of Christ Jesus, who, existing in the form of God, did not consider equality with God as something to be exploited. Instead he emptied himself by assuming the form of a servant, taking on the likeness of humanity. And when he had come as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death – even to death on a cross. For this reason God highly exalted him and gave him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee will bow – in heaven and on earth and under the earth – and every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Philippians 2:5-11

3. Attention

Present Bibles

THE WAY I SHOULD ACT *(Pause)*

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV – The Way I Should Act (1 Timothy 4:11-16) These things command and teach. Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity. Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine. Neglect not the gift that is in thee, which was given thee by prophecy, with the laying on of the hands of the presbytery. Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all. Take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine; continue in them: for in doing this thou shalt both save thyself, and them that hear thee.
1 Timothy 4:11-16

CSB – The Way I Should Act (1 Timothy 4:11-16) Command and teach these things. Don't let anyone despise your youth; but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, and in purity. Until I come, give your attention to public reading, exhortation, and teaching. Do not neglect the gift that is in you; it was given to you through prophecy, with the laying on of hands by the council of elders. Practice these things; be committed to them, so that your progress may be evident to all. Pay close attention to your life and your teaching; persevere in these things, for in doing this you will save both yourself and your hearers. 1Timothy 4:11-16

This ends the Key Biblical Passage Drill.

MARRIAGE RELATIONSHIP *(Pause)*

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV— Marriage Relationship (Ephesians 5:22-23) Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord. For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.
Ephesians 5:22-23

CSB — Marriage Relationship (Ephesians 5:22-23) Wives, submit to your husbands as to the Lord, because the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church. He is the Savior of the body. Ephesians 5:22-23

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We are finished! Thank you, students for doing such a wonderful job. Our judges will now leave to tally the results of our Drill. Parents, at this time it will be fine to take pictures. While our Judges are getting the results together, we will say the Books of the Bible. Number one, will you begin, please?

(You may use this time in several ways. Testimonies by drillers of what Bible Drill means to them or sharing a fun time their Bible Drill has shared together are some possibilities as you wait for the Judges to return.)
