



Youth Bible Drill 2027

Practice Drill- Red Cycle

- A caller will call only the King James Version of the calls, if all drillers are using the KJV
- A caller will call only the Christian Standard Bible version of the calls, if all drillers are using the CSB
- The caller will need to call KJV and CSB calls if all translations are being used in a drill.

Welcome to Youth Practice Bible Drill. My name is _____. I will be your Caller today. We are here to rejoice in the fact that these students have desired to worship and honor God by hiding His Word in their heart. Thank you, parents, for encouraging and supporting your students. We know today is a special day for them and for you as well.

A special thank you to our judges and timekeeper. (Introduce them.)

To help us have a good day, let's go over the Rules of the Room. It is vital that you do the following:

- No picture taking *during* the Drill. We allow time for pictures after the Drill. Also, for the safety of all our drillers video recording will not be allowed during our drill.
- If you leave the room for any reason, do not re-enter the room.
- Place everything in your hands under your chair at this time. (Pause and watch while they do it.)
- Help us eliminate distractions such as turning off cell phones, electronic games, and devices. Please turn them off now. (Pause while they do it.)
- Remain as quiet as possible, with no prompting from the audience. If a young child becomes distracting, then please leave the room as quickly and quietly as possible until the Drill is complete.

Turn towards the Students.

Students, I want to remind you:

- **Keep your hands at your side until I say "attention."**
- **Your eyes are to stay on me until I say "start."**
- **Do not step out if you don't know the answer.**
- **Place your index finger on your Bible before stepping out.**
- **If you start forward when "time" is called, come on out. Let the judges decide if you "beat the clock."**

- If you step forward, don't go back. If you stepped forward mistakenly, please raise your hand.
- Treat your Bible with respect.

Are there any questions? (Allow time for questions)

Let's start with a word of prayer. (Pray.)

We will begin our drill.

BOOK DRILL:

Our first section will be the "Book Drill". I will call the name of a book. You will locate the book, place your index finger on any verse in that book and step forward. When called upon, you will name the book before, the book called, and the book that follows.

EXODUS (pause)
Start. (Call on a driller after "time" has been called.)

ANSWER: Genesis – **EXODUS** – Leviticus

2. Attention.
Present Bibles.
1 CORINTHIANS (pause)
Start. (Call on a driller after "time" has been called.)

ANSWER: Romans – **1 CORINTHIANS** – 2 Corinthians

3. Attention.
Present Bibles.
PROVERBS (pause)
Start. (Call on a driller after "time" has been called.)

ANSWER: Psalms – **PROVERBS** – Ecclesiastes

4. Attention.
Present Bibles.
MARK (pause)
Start. (Call on a driller after "time" has been called.)

ANSWER: Matthew – **MARK** – Luke

5. Attention.
Present Bibles.
HEBREWS (pause)
Start. (*Call on a driller after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER: Philemon – **HEBREWS** – James

JEREMIAH (pause)
Start. (*Call on a driller after “time” has been called.*)

Isaiah – **JEREMIAH** – Lamentations

SCRIPTURE SEARCHING DRILL:

We will now begin the “Scripture Searching Drill”. I will call a Scripture verse. You will locate the verse, place your index finger on the verse and step forward. When called upon, you will read the verse and give the Scripture reference.

1. Attention.
Present Bibles.
HEBREWS 13:1 (pause)
Start. (*Call on a driller after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER:

KJV– Let brotherly love continue. Hebrews 13:1

CSB - Let brotherly love continue. Hebrews 13:1

2. Attention.
Present Bibles.
JOHN 10:2 (pause)
Start. (*Call on a driller after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER:

KJV– But he that entereth in by the door is the shepherd of the sheep. John 10:2

CSB - The one who enters by the gate is the shepherd of the sheep. John 10:2

3. Attention.

Present Bibles.

GENESIS 15:6 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV– And he believed in the Lord; and he counted it to him for righteousness.
Genesis 15:6

CSB - Abram believed the LORD, and he credited it to him as righteousness. Genesis 15:6

4. Attention.

Present Bibles.

PHILIPPIANS 2:5 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV– Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus. Philippians 2:5

CSB - Adopt the same. Attitude as that of Christ Jesus, Philippians 2:5

5. Attention.

Present Bibles.

JAMES 4:17 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV– Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.
James 4:17

CSB - So it is sin to know the good and yet not do it. James 4:17

Extra call if needed:

Attention.

Present Bibles.

ROMANS 10:13 *(pause)*

Start. *(Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV – For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. Romans 10:13

CSB - For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. Romans 10:13

IDENTIFYING VERSES DRILL:

I will quote the underlined part of the Scripture verse. You will locate the verse in your Bible; place your index finger on the verse, and step forward. When called upon, read the entire verse and give the reference. (I will give the KJV first and then the CSB)

1. Attention

Present Bibles.

KJV: then ye shall be a peculiar treasure

CSB: you will be my own possession out of all the peoples,

(pause)

Start. *(Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV – Now therefore, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth is mine: Exodus 19:5

CSB - Now if you will carefully listen to me and keep my covenant, you will be my own possession out of all the peoples, although the whole earth is mine, Exodus 19:5

2. Attention

Present Bibles.

KJV: I will put my law in their inward parts,

CSB: I will put my teaching within them

(pause)

Start. *(Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV – But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people. Jeremiah 31:33

CSB – “Instead, this is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after those days”—the LORD’S declaration. “I will put my teaching within them and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people.” Jeremiah 31:33

3. Attention

Present Bibles.

KJV: Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast,

CSB: Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, be steadfast,

(pause)

Start. *(Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV – Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.

1 Corinthians 15:58

CSB - Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, be steadfast, immovable, always excelling in the Lord’s work, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain.

1 Corinthians 15:58

4. Attention

Present Bibles.

KJV: Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

CSB: Adopt the same attitude as that of Christ Jesus,

(pause)

Start. *(Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV – Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men. Philippians 2:5-7

CSB - Adopt the same attitude as that of Christ Jesus, who, existing in the form of God, did not consider equality with God as something to be exploited. Instead he emptied himself by assuming the form of a servant, taking on the likeness of humanity. Philippians 2:5-7a

5. Attention

Present Bibles.

KJV: But let us, who are of the day,

CSB: But since we belong to the day,

(pause)

Start. *(Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV – But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and
for an helmet, the hope of salvation. For God hath not appointed us to wrath,
but to
obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ, 1 Thessalonians 5:8-9

CSB - But since we belong to the day, let us be self-controlled and put on the armor of faith and
love, and a helmet of the hope of salvation. For God did not appoint us to
wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ. 1
Thessalonians 5:8-9

Extra call if needed:

Attention

Present Bibles.

KJV: Trust in him at all times;

CSB: Trust in him at all times,

(pause)

Start. *(Call on a driller after “time” has been called.)*

ANSWER:

KJV – Trust in him at all times; ye people, pour out your heart before him: God is a
refuge for us. Selah. Psalm 62:8

CSB - Trust in him at all times, you people; pour out your hearts before him. God is
our refuge. Selah Psalm 62:8

DOCTRINAL DRILL:

We will now begin the Doctrinal Drill. I will give you a doctrinal statement; you will locate the verse that corresponds with that doctrinal subject. Place your index finger on the verse, then step out. When called upon, you will state the doctrine, read the verse, and give the reference. (You may state these in the order that is most comfortable for you).

1. Attention

Present Bibles.

EDUCATION (*pause*)

Start. (*Call on a driller after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER:

KJV – Thus saith the LORD, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; I am the LORD thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go.
Isaiah 48:17

CSB – This is what the LORD, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel says: I am the LORD your God, who teaches you for your benefit, who leads you in the way you should go.
Isaiah 48:17

2. Attention

Present Bibles.

GOD (*pause*)

Start. (*Call on a driller after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER:

KJV – And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. John 1:14

CSB - The Word became flesh and dwelt among us. We observed his glory, the glory as the one and only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth. John 1:14

3. Attention

Present Bibles.

EVANGELISM AND MISSIONS (*pause*)

Start (*Call on a driller after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER:

KJV – And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!
Romans 10:15

CSB – And how can they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news. Romans 10:15

4. Attention

Present Bibles.

SCRIPTURE (*pause*)

Start. (*Call on a driller after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER:

KJV – Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation. For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost. 2 Peter 1:20-21

CSB – Above all, you know this: No prophecy of Scripture comes from the prophet's own interpretation, because no prophecy ever came by the will of man; instead, men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit. 2 Peter 1:20-21

5. Attention

Present Bibles.

THE CHURCH (*pause*)

Start. (*Call on a driller after “time” has been called.*)

ANSWER:

KJV – Saying, I will declare thy name unto my brethren, in the midst of the church will I sing praise unto thee. Hebrews 2:12

CSB – saying: I will proclaim your name to my brothers and sisters; I will sing hymns to you in the congregation. Hebrews 2:12

Extra call if needed:

Attention

Present Bibles.

THE LORD'S DAY (*pause*)

Start (*Call on a driller after "time" has been called.*)

ANSWER:

KJV – Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. Exodus 20:8

CSB – Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy: Exodus 20:8

BIBLE ANSWERS DRILL:

I will ask a question. You will locate the verse that answers the question, place your index finger on the verse and step forward. When time is called, I will instruct you to close your Bibles. When called upon, please quote the question, recite the verse WORD FOR WORD, and state the reference.

I. Attention

Present Bibles

WHO SHOULD I TRUST? – (*pause*)

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV – Trust ye in the Lord for ever: for in the LORD JEHOVAH is everlasting strength. Isaiah 26:4

CSB - Trust in the LORD forever, because in the LORD, the LORD himself, is an everlasting rock! Isaiah 26:4

2. Attention

Present Bible

WHAT DOES JESUS REQUIRE OF ME? *(pause)*

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV – Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me. Matthew 16:24

CSB - Then Jesus said to his disciples, “If anyone wants to follow after me, let him deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me. Matthew 16:24

3. Attention

Present Bibles

WHO LIVES IN ME? *(pause)*

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV – I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me. Galatians 2:20

CSB - I have been crucified with Christ, and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me. Galatians 2:20

4. Attention

Present Bibles

HOW CAN I RESIST THE DEVIL? *(pause)*

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV – Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
James 4:7

CSB – Therefore, submit to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. James
4:7

5. Attention-
Present Bibles
WHO IS JESUS? (pause)
Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV – Whosoever shall confess that Jesus is the Son of God, God dwelleth in him, and he in God. 1 John 4:15

CSB - Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God — God remains in him and he in God.
1 John 4:15

Extra call if needed:

Attention

Present Bibles

AM I ALONE? (pause)

Start (After time is called instruct drillers: close your Bibles. Call on driller to respond)

ANSWER:

KJV – Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest.
Joshua 1:9

CSB - Haven't I commanded you: be strong and courageous? Do not be afraid or discouraged, for the
LORD your God is with you wherever you go." Joshua 1:9

We are finished! Thank you, students for doing such a wonderful job. Our judges will now leave to tally the results of our Drill. Parents, at this time it will be fine to take pictures. While our Judges are getting the results together, we will say the Books of the Bible. Number one, will you begin please?

(You may use this time in several ways. Testimonies by drillers of what Bible Drill means to them or sharing a fun time their Bible Drill has shared together are some possibilities as you wait for the Judges to return.)
