- A caller will call only the King James Version of the calls, if all drillers are using the KJV
- A caller will call only the Christian Standard Bible version of the calls, if all drillers are using the CSB
- The caller will need to call KJV and CSB calls if all translations are being used in a drill.

Welcome to _____ (Church) Bible Drill. My name is _____. I will be your Caller today. We are here to rejoice in the fact that these students have desired to worship and honor God by hiding His Word in their heart. Thank you, parents, for encouraging and supporting your students. We know today is a special day for them and for you as well.

A special thank you to our judges and timekeeper. (Introduce them.)

To help us have a good day, let's go over the Rules of the Room. It is vital that you do the following:

- No picture taking *during* the Drill. We allow time for pictures after the Drill. Also, for the safety of all our drillers video recording will not be allowed during our drill.
- If you leave the room for any reason, do not re-enter the room.
- Place everything in your hands under your chair at this time. (Pause and watch while they do it.)
- Help us eliminate distractions such as turning off cell phones, electronic games, and devices. Please turn them off now. (Pause while they do it.)
- Remain as quiet as possible, with no prompting from the audience. If a young child becomes distracting, then please leave the room as quickly and quietly as possible until the Drill is complete.

Turn towards the Students.

Students, I want to remind you:

- **Keep your hands at your side until I say “attention.”**
- **Your eyes are to stay on me until I say “start.”**
- **Do not step out if you don't know the answer.**
- **Place your index finger on your Bible before stepping out.**
- **If you start forward when “time” is called, come on out. Let the judges decide if you “beat the clock.”**
- **If you step forward, don't go back. If you stepped forward mistakenly, please raise your hand.**

- If you are called upon, take one step forward to answer. After answering step back.
- Treat your Bible with respect.

Are there any questions? (Allow time for questions)

Let's start with a word of prayer. (Pray.)

We will begin our drill.

BOOK DRILL:

I will call the name of a book. You will locate the book, place your index finger on any verse in that book and step forward. When called upon, you will name the book before, the book called, and the book that follows.

1. Attention – Present Bibles – **HEBREWS** - Start

(Philemon – **HEBREWS** – James)

2. Attention – Present Bibles – **MICAH** - Start

(Jonah – **MICAH** – Nahum)

3. Attention – Present Bibles – **MALACHI** - Start

(Zechariah – **MALACHI** – Matthew)

4. Attention – Present Bibles – **EXODUS** - Start

(Genesis – **EXODUS** – Leviticus)

5. Attention – Present Bibles – **ACTS** - Start

(John – **ACTS** – Romans)

Extra call if needed:

Attention – Present Bibles – **OBADIAH** – Start

(Amos – **OBADIAH** – Jonah)

SCRIPTURE SEARCHING DRILL:

I will call a Scripture verse. You will locate the verse, place your index finger on the verse and step forward. When called upon, you will read the verse and give the Scripture reference.

1. Attention – Present Bibles – MATTHEW 9:38 – Start

KJV– Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest.

(Matthew 9:38)

CSB - Therefore, pray to the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into this harvest.”

(Matthew 9:38)

2. Attention – Present Bibles – PROVERBS 29:25 – Start

KJV– The fear of man bringeth a snare: but whoso putteth his trust in the LORD shall be safe.

(Proverbs 29:25)

CSB - The fear of mankind is a snare, but the one who trusts in the LORD is protected.

(Proverbs 29:25)

3. Attention – Present Bibles – JEREMIAH 33:3 – Start

KJV– Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and shew thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not. (Jeremiah 33:3)

CSB - Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and incomprehensible things you do

not know. (Jeremiah 33:3)

4. Attention – Present Bibles – **MARK 1:15** – Start

KJV– And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel. (Mark 1:15)

CSB - “The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near. Repent and believe the good news!” (Mark 1:15)

5. Attention – Present Bibles – **JOHN 3:18** – Start

KJV– He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.
(John 3:18)

CSB - Anyone who believes in him is not condemned, but anyone who does not believe is already condemned, because he has not believed in the name of the one and only Son of God. (John 3:18)

Extra call if needed: Attention – Present Bibles- **PSALM 8:1** – Start

KJV – O LORD our Lord, how excellent *is* thy name in all the earth! who hast set thy glory above the heavens. (Psalm 8:1)

CSB - LORD, our Lord, how magnificent is your name throughout the earth! You have covered the heavens with your majesty. (Psalm 8:1)

IDENTIFYING VERSES DRILL:

I will quote the underlined part of the Scripture verse. You will locate the verse in your Bible; place your index finger on the verse, and step forward. When called upon, read the entire verse and give the reference. (I will give the KJV first and then the CSB)

1. Attention – Present Bibles – (give portion of verse underlined) – Start

KJV – Now therefore, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth is mine: (Exodus 19:5)

CSB - Now if you will carefully listen to me and keep my covenant, you will be my own possession out of all the peoples, although the whole earth is mine, (Exodus 19:5)

2. Attention – Present Bibles – (give portion of verse underlined) – Start

KJV – And he said unto his disciples, Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life,
what ye shall eat; neither for the body, what ye shall put on. The life is more than meat,
and the body is more than raiment. (Luke 12:22-23)

CSB - Then he said to his disciples: "Therefore I tell you, don't worry about your life, what
you will eat; or about the body, what you will wear. For life is more than food
and the body more than clothing. (Luke 12:22-23)

3. Attention – Present Bibles – (give portion of verse underlined) – Start

KJV – Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.
(I Corinthians 15:58)

CSB - Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, be steadfast, immovable, always excelling in the Lord’s work, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain.
(I Corinthians 15:58)

4. Attention – Present Bibles – (give portion of verse underlined) – Start

KJV – But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people. (Jeremiah 31:33)

CSB – “Instead, this is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after those days”—the LORD’S declaration. “I will put my teaching within them and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people.” (Jeremiah 31:33)

5. Attention – Present Bibles – (give portion of verse underlined) – Start

KJV – Trust in him at all times; ye people, pour out your heart before him: God is a refuge for us. Selah. (Psalm 62:8)

CSB - Trust in him at all times, you people; pour out your hearts before him. God is our refuge. Selah (Psalm 62:8)

Extra call if needed: Attention – Present Bibles – (give portion of verse underlined) – Start

KJV – But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation. For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ, (1 Thessalonians 5:8-9)

CSB - But since we belong to the day, let us be self-controlled and put on the armor of faith and love, and a helmet of the hope of salvation. For God did not appoint us to wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Thessalonians 5:8-9)

DOCTRINAL DRILL:

I will give you a doctrinal statement; you will locate the verse that corresponds with that doctrinal subject. Place your index finger on the verse, then step out. When called upon, you will state the doctrine, read the verse, and give the reference. (You may state these in the order that is most comfortable for you).

1. Attention – Present Bibles – EDUCATION – Start

KJV – Thus saith the LORD, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; I am the LORD thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go. (Isaiah 48:17)

CSB - This is what the LORD, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel says: I am the LORD your God, who teaches you for your benefit, who leads you in the way you should go. (Isaiah 48:17)

2. Attention -Present Bibles – RELIGIOUS LIBERTY- Start

KJV – Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men. (Acts 5:29)

CSB - Peter and the apostles replied, "We must obey God rather than people. (Acts 5:29)

3. Attention- Present Bibles –GRACE - Start

KJV – Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need. (Hebrews 4:16)

CSB - Therefore, let us approach the throne of grace with boldness, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in time of need. (Hebrews 4:16)

4. Attention- Present Bibles – THE LORD’S DAY -Start

KJV – Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. (Exodus 20:8)

CSB - Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy: (Exodus 20:8)

5. Attention- Present Bibles – LAST THINGS -Start

KJV – And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come. (Matthew 24:14)

CSB – This good news of the kingdom will be proclaimed in all the world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come. (Matthew 24:14)

Extra call if needed: Attention- Present Bibles – **GOD** -Start

KJV – And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. (John 1:14)

CSB - The Word became flesh and dwelt among us. We observed his glory, the glory as the one and only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth. (John 1:14)

BIBLE ANSWERS DRILL:

I will ask a question. You will locate the verse that answers the question, place your index finger on the verse and step forward. When time is called, I will instruct you to close your Bibles. When called upon, please quote the question, recite the verse WORD FOR WORD, and state the reference.

- 1. Attention-** Present Bibles –**HOW CAN I MINISTER TO OTHERS?** -Start -(Close your Bibles, after time is called)

KJV- As every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. (1 Peter 4:10)

CSB - Just as each one has received a gift, use it to serve others, as good stewards of the varied grace of God. (1 Peter 4:10)

- 2. Attention-** Present Bibles –**HOW DID GOD SHOW HIS LOVE TO ME?** Start – (Close your Bibles, after time is called)

KJV- But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. (Romans 5:8)

CSB - But God proves his own love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. (Romans 5:8)

- 3. Attention-** Present Bibles –**WHO IS JESUS?** -Start (Close your Bibles, after time is called)

KJV – Whosoever shall confess that Jesus is the Son of God, God dwelleth in him, and he in God. (1 John 4:15)

CSB - Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God — God remains in him and he in God. (1 John 4:15)

4. Attention - Present Bibles –**WHO LIVES IN ME?** -Start (Close your Bibles, after time is called)

KJV – I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me. (Galatians 2:20)

CSB - I have been crucified with Christ, and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me. (Galatians 2:20)

5. Attention- Present Bibles –**WHO DID CHRIST JESUS COME TO SAVE?** -Start (Close your Bibles, after time is called)

KJV – This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief. (1Timothy 1:15)

CSB - This saying is trustworthy and deserving of full acceptance: "Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners" —and I am the worst of them. (1Timothy 1:15)

Extra call if needed:

Attention- Present Bibles –**WHO SHOULD I TRUST?** –Start (Close your Bibles, after time is called)

KJV – Trust ye in the Lord for ever: for in the LORD JEHOVAH is everlasting strength.
(Isaiah 26:4)

CSB - Trust in the LORD forever, because in the LORD, the LORD himself, is an everlasting
rock! (Isaiah 26:4)

We are finished! Thank you, students for doing such a wonderful job. Our judges will now leave to tally the results of our Drill. Parents, at this time it will be fine to take pictures. While our Judges are getting the results together, we will say the Books of the Bible. Number one, will you begin please?

(You may use this time in several ways. Testimonies by drillers of what Bible Drill means to them or sharing a fun time their Bible Drill has shared together are some possibilities as you wait for the Judges to return.)
